# **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

ROAD BLOCKS | HURT JANUARY 12/13

### FOR STARTERS

- 1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
- 2. As a group, list the many ways you have experienced hurt. Share briefly about your hurt what was it, how did/does it impact you and how did God help you through?

#### **DIGGING IN**

- 1. Read Psalm 10:1-11
  - How did hurt affect the Psalmist's spiritual life?
  - List 3-5 characteristics of the person who does the hurting?
  - What impact does the pain have on the Psalmist? Look at verses 1 and 10.
- 2. Read Psalm 10:12-18
  - What is the victim asking God to do?
  - What is the victim believing about God?
  - Stuck between a belief in God's eternal reign (v16) and His ultimate victory over evil (v18), what does the victim say about God in v17?
- 3. Look up the following verses and remember again God's response to those who hurt.
  - Psalm 34:18
  - Psalm 147:3
  - Isaiah 43:2-3; Isaiah 53:5; Isaiah 61:1 (Jesus used this verse to announce His ministry!)
  - 1 Peter 2:23; 1 Peter 5:10

#### **BRINGING IT HOME**

- 1. From this week's message, what is God asking you to do and how can the group help you?
- 2. How can we better help those who hurt in light of this message?
- 3. Who do you need to forgive or ask for forgiveness?
- 4. When Jesus suffered, Peter tells us he entrusted himself to God (1Peter 2:23-24). Referencing Psalm 10, what does that look like?
