DISCUSSION GUIDE

HOLY WEEK | JESUS HAD NEEDS TOO! APRIL 13/14 | MARK 11:1-22

FOR STARTERS

- 1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
- 2. As a group, list ways you can provide for the needs of Jesus as He seeks to save the lost.

DIGGING IN

- 1. Read Mark 16:15. Discuss as a group what your "world" is and how you can reach those for Christ.
- 2. What signs have you witnessed by following Jesus' Great Commission?
- 3. Discuss the significance of Jesus riding in on a colt that had never been ridden before.
- 4. On the third day of Holy Week (Tuesday), Jesus taught the disciples about believing, praying and forgiving (Mark 11:22-25). How have you demonstrated believing God? What are you praying to God for? How have you been forgiving others for their trespasses against you?
- 5. Discuss as a group how an unforgiving heart can hinder prayers and faith.

BRINGING IT HOME

- 1. How can you walk with those who are struggling to believe?
- 2. How can you encourage those who struggle to pray?
- 3. How can you witness to those who struggle to forgive others?
- 4. In the coming weeks, find an individual or family to share supper with (home or restaurant) and express your love and appreciation to them.
