HOLY WEEK | JESUS HAD NEEDS TOO!

APRIL 13/14 | MARK 11:1-22

FOR STARTERS

1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
2. As a group, list ways you can provide for the needs of Jesus as He seeks to save the lost.

DIGGING IN

1. Read Mark 16:15. Discuss as a group what your "world" is and how you can reach those for Christ.
2. What signs have you witnessed by following Jesus' Great Commission?
3. Discuss the significance of Jesus riding in on a colt that had never been ridden before.
4. On the third day of Holy Week (Tuesday), Jesus taught the disciples about believing, praying and forgiving (Mark 11:22-25). How have you demonstrated believing God? What are you praying to God for? How have you been forgiving others for their trespasses against you?
5. Discuss as a group how an unforgiving heart can hinder prayers and faith.

BRINGING IT HOME

1. How can you walk with those who are struggling to believe?
2. How can you encourage those who struggle to pray?
3. How can you witness to those who struggle to forgive others?
4. In the coming weeks, find an individual or family to share supper with (home or restaurant) and express your love and appreciation to them.
