## DISCUSSION GUIDE ROAD BLOCKS | PRIDE MAY 11/12 | ESTHER 5-7

### FOR STARTERS

- 1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
- 2. As a group, list the many ways that pride has manifested in your lives and shown itself as our enemy.

#### **DIGGING IN**

- 1. Read the following Proverbs on pride and learn how pride is our enemy: Proverbs 11:2, 13:10, 15:25, 16:5, 18 and 29:23.
- 2. What do we learn from the first story about pride concerning Satan? Look up Isaiah 14:12-14 and Ezekiel 8:1-2.
- 3. When it comes to humility, what is commanded? Look up 1 Peter 5:5-6 and James 4:7.
- 4. How does Jesus and the cross demonstrate and lead us to befriend humility? Look up Philippians 2:5-11.
- 5. What does humility look like in real time? Look up Philippians 2:3-4.
- 6. Matthew 5:3 states that the humble (poor in spirit) inherit the kingdom of heaven. How do the beatitudes (Matthew 5:4-12) relate to walking in humility?

#### **BRINGING IT HOME**

- 1. From the message this week, what is God asking you to do and how can this group help you?
- 2. How can we encourage each other as we find ourselves constantly badgered by pride?
- 3. How does our relationship with God through Christ free us from pride? Look at Psalm 139 and celebrate God's love and care for us.
- 4. Use Psalm 139:23-24 as a closing prayer.
