DISCUSSION GUIDE NOVEMBER 16/17 | WHAT MATTERS? THE PRIORITY OF GENEROSITY

FOR STARTERS

- 1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
- 2. What are you learning or have learned/experienced about first and best giving and moving up the ladder of generosity?

DIGGING IN

- 1. We often hear it said, "It's not what God wants from us, but for us." He doesn't need our money; He wants our hearts to be full of faith–living with and for Him. Read Philippians 4:15-19. What did God want for the Philippian church?
- 2. When God's people don't trust Him, they discover there's a "hole in their pocket." Read Haggai 1:2-11 and find out how that happens.
- 3. Proverbs is chock full of wisdom pertaining to generous giving. Read the following and note the truths:
 - Proverbs 11:24-28
 - Proverbs 15:27
 - Proverbs 21:25-26
 - Proverbs 22:9 and 19:17
 - Psalm 37:25-26
- 4. Jesus teaches us to not worry, but trust Him for all that we need. Read Matthew 6:24-33 and summarize His teaching in your own words.

BRINGING IT HOME

- Where is God asking you to trust Him? What are you missing out on? What does the next step look like for you?
- 2. As a group, memorize Proverbs 3:9-10. Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the first fruits of all your crops; then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.
- 3. Take the Tithe Challenge: Give 10% (or a lesser %) of your net income back to God. Write down what God is teaching you. If anyone is doing this, share your experience.
