DISCUSSION GUIDE

FOR STARTERS

- 1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, what caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
- 2. Share and describe a person in your life who you look to as a model as you seek to grow to be more like Jesus.

DIGGING IN

- 1. Read Philippians 2:12-18. Partnering with God and each other.
 - a. What's the difference between working for your salvation and working it out? Look up Ephesians 2:8-10.
 - b. What does God's work in us produce? Look at v13.
 - c. What are the marks (several are noted) of the church (individuals too) when it comes to "working out your salvation"? Look at vv12-17.
 - d. Why the fuss over grumbling and complaining (v14)? Look up Numbers 14:1-4, 10-12, 1 Thessalonians 5:18 and Ephesians 5:20.
- 2. Read Philippians 2:19-30. Following godly examples—Timothy and Epaphroditus.
 - a. What are the qualities that stand out in Timothy? (vv19-24, 1 Corinthians 4:16-17)
 - b. What are the qualities that stand out in Epaphroditus (vv25-30) and how do they connect to what was said earlier in Philippians 2:3-5?
 - c. What are we called to do with godly leaders? Look at v29, 1 Corinthians 11:1 and Hebrews 13:7.

BRINGING IT HOME

- 1. Where is God using this week's message to grow you so that we might better shine for Jesus?
- 2. What new things are you learning about God and His commitment to us (individually and together)? Don't forget Philippians 1:6, along with 2:13.
- 3. If working out our faith (salvation) is something we do together as God's people, what are ways you as a group can encourage and strengthen each other as followers of Jesus?
- 4. Write or text someone whose godly example you honor to encourage and thank them.
